1. Registered voter in municipality
2. Registered voter in Ward in which filed
3. Twenty-one (21) years of age
4. Affiliated with political party for 90 days by date of filing notice of candidacy (i.e., File on last day of filing, party affiliation must have been changed by April 19, 2009. GS 163-106 (b))
